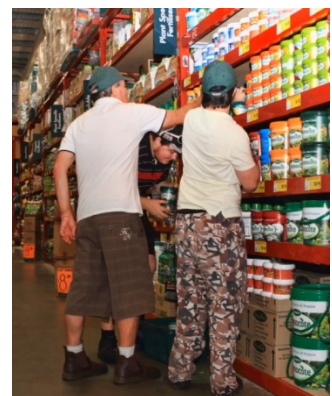
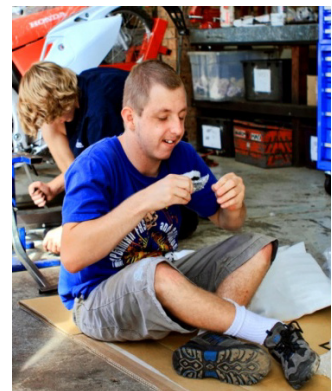
Partnerships with companies like Bunnings, Woolworths and the Hope Shop have provided win-win outcomes for both employers and employees.
